Dear coin collectors and coin enthusiasts,

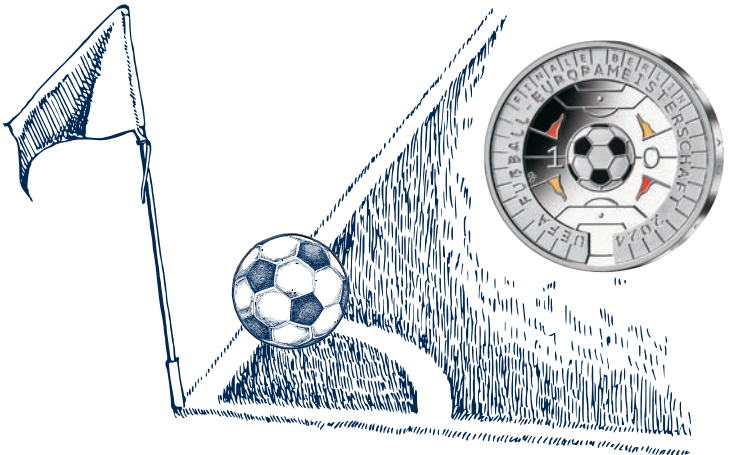

This 20 euro collector coin commemorates the very foundation of our democracy. Our Basic Law was proclaimed on 23 May 1949 and came into force on the following day. Initially created as a provisional constitution for the Federal Republic of Germany, the Basic Law has applied to the whole of Germany since the accession of the states from the former GDR.

The remarkable grasshopper

There are around 80 different types of grasshopper in Germany. The great green bush-cricket is particularly eye-catching, with its striking, predominantly green colouring and its head which has a similar shape to that of a horse. It is the largest grasshopper species in the country, growing up to 40 mm in size. The image covers most of the coin surface and portrays a female green bush-cricket resting on a leaf in its habitat. The distinctive ‘spindly’ look of the grasshopper’s legs is cleverly combined with the plant stalks in the background.

A valuable insect

The marmalade hoverfly is one of around 450 species of hoverfly in Germany. Its yellow and black colours are highly distinctive, and somewhat reminiscent of a wasp. This protects it against predators, even though it is completely harmless and does not sting. Its larvae devour aphids, while the adult insects are important pollinators. The body of the insect and the flowers around it are delicately modelled on the raised coin motif, while the insect's wings are expertly depicted in a transparent style.

A formidable beetle

With a body size of 9 cm, the stag beetle is the largest beetle found in Central Europe. Its main source of food is tree resin. The stag beetle has the conservation status 'endangered' in Germany and is a protected species. The coin depicts a typical male stag beetle with the correct morphological details. Its distinctive black and brown colours add emphasis to the standout feature of this beetle – its enlarged upper jaws, or mandibles.

Furry nectar gatherer

The red-tailed bumblebee gets its name from the reddish markings around its abdomen and is known to nest under heaps of stones or at the base of old walls.

Its reddish colour is just as distinctive as its bushy fur. At the centre of the vivid coin motif is a red-tailed bumblebee seen from the side, seemingly in the process of collecting nectar. The furry structure of the insect's body is highlighted by the slightly roughened relief of the coin.

A guarantee of safety

To protect its citizens: this duty on the part of the state is derived from Germany's Basic Law. This is the responsibility of various security authorities, and first and foremost the police. The coin motif highlights the police force's unconditional commitment and availability. In the centre, enclosed by a polymer ring in the distinctive blue colour of the police force, are two officers in uniform, confidently and openly facing the viewer, thus signalling their approachability.

A thrilling event

Football is the national sport of many countries. The men's European Championship will take place in Germany in 2024 and is sure to excite football fans and casual observers alike. This coin was created in collaboration with the German Football Association (DFB) and has a very special value, in keeping with the old footballing adage that it is important for a team to be 'eleven friends on the pitch'. One of the themes of the motif is the iconic roof architecture of the Olympic Stadium in Berlin, where the final will be held.

A revolutionary philosopher

Immanuel Kant (1724–1804) was considered to be the most influential thinker of his era during his lifetime – and is now regarded as the most important philosopher of modern times. The coin motif combines a silhouette of the philosopher, based on contemporary styles, with a starry sky and the quote ‘Der bestirnte Himmel über mir und das moralische Gesetz in mir’ (the starry heavens above me and the moral law within me), clearly focusing on two key elements of Kant’s ideas.

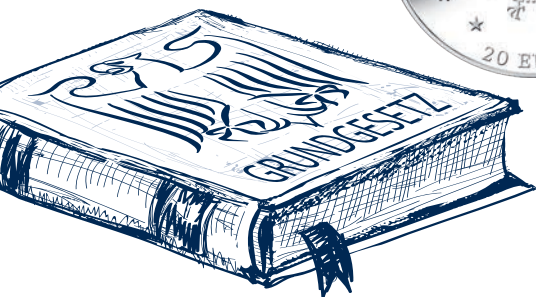

A historic milestone

May 2024 marks the 75th anniversary of the proclamation and entry into force of Germany's Basic Law. This lays out the unalterable fundamental rights for all citizens, regulates the coexistence of citizens and takes precedence over all other German laws, which must be in keeping with this. Alongside an abstract depiction of the parliamentary seating plan, the coin motif

highlights the first article of the Basic Law in a clear, minimalist style: 'Die Würde des Menschen ist unantastbar' (human dignity is inviolable).

An emi-



nent literary figure

Erich Kästner, one of the most translated writers of the twentieth century, was not only an author, but also a lyricist, publicist, screenwriter and satirist. In addition to his poetry, which was often both humorous and melancholic, his books for children and teenagers – which are known in (almost) every household in Germany – are timeless classics. This attractive coin pays tribute both to the person and to his life's work with an eye-catching profile of the writer along with a striking use of colour on the book spines. On the obverse side, the wings of Germany's national symbol, the eagle, appear to be made of book pages.

***A glowing wreath***

Putting up an Advent wreath in the run-up to Christmas is a relatively recent tradition. It began with the pastor Johann Hinrich Wichern, who hung up the first Advent wreath in 1839 at a school in Hamburg, at that time consisting of a wagon wheel with 24 candles. Over the years, the number of candles was reduced to four, and an evergreen wreath with sprigs of fir has been favoured since around 1860. The coin motif interprets this in a multi-faceted way, with a nod to its historical evolution. The comet above the wreath establishes a link to the star of Bethlehem and the birth of Jesus.

A dynamic master builder

As a consequence of hunting by humans, the Eurasian beaver was wiped out of large parts of Europe and almost all of Germany in the nineteenth century. Thanks to stringent conservation measures and reintroductions, populations have recovered significantly over the last few decades. The coin motif features an accurate depiction of Germany's largest rodent, which shapes the landscape according to its needs like no other animal. The fur is particularly vivid around the head, while the tail and front paws are also richly detailed.

A much-loved theatre classic

The comedy 'Der zerbrochne Krug' (The Broken Jug) is one of the best-known and most-performed dramas by Heinrich von Kleist (1777–1811): in a court hearing in the fictional Dutch village of Huisum, the local judge, Adam, has to conduct a trial against himself, as he is the real culprit who broke the jug that gives the play its title. The coin motif sums up the past, present and future of the events, focusing on the rich ensemble of central characters and featuring impressive attention to detail.

Democratic awakening

This is considered to be the first national constitution created on German soil. Although the Frankfurt Constitution, signed at St. Paul's Church in Frankfurt, never actually came into effect, it is regarded as a milestone in the history of German democracy. The coin motif offers a powerful visual representation of what is quite an intangible theme and brings together different ideas in an almost cinematic manner: St. Paul's Church, the constitutional document and the female allegories of 'unity', 'justice' and 'freedom'.
